CANAL TOLLS VOTE COMING THIS WEEK

Only Anti-Trust Measures
Stand in Way of Adjournment—Some Senators in
Favor of Curtailing Trust
Program.

Washington, May 31.—The bill awaiting vote on the tolls exemption repeal bill will be taken in the senate before Saturday night unless all the plans of the leaders fail. Both opponents and supporters of the bill and of the measure are agreed that there is no need for prolonging debate beyond the present week, and when the few speeches already announced have been made, the bill will be voted on the bill and all the amendments proposed to it.

There is a prospect that the house will finish its trip of anti-trust bills by the end of the week and the two houses will adjourn July 1. If state leaders can reach an agreement on the amount of trust legislation they will do the country and need and desire at this time.

Anti-Trust Measures.

The opposition bill can be passed in a few hours, but the Senate will not, and practically only the trust program stands in the way of adjournment by July 1. The leaders of the Senate committee in charge of the bill have had a week's hard work on anti-trust bills before them, and expect to reach a decision on the much legislation it will recommend to the Senate by the middle of the week. There is a motion now to adjourn the Senate, but only one bill will be taken in the hope that with its passage adjournment will be taken with the Senate in session. Other trust legislation shall be brought before the Senate next week.

The fact that President Taft's recent reports to Congress on Illinois and other measures are regarded in some quarters as an attempt to bring the Senate to a standstill with less than all three bills to be passed by the end of the session, is felt that the passage of a trade commission bill as a senatorial bill will be the last to be taken.

Frost Test on Tolls Repeal.

The tolls repeal bill will lie on the table in the Senate until the vote is taken, but the first test for the senators who favor arbitration of the question of Atlanta's right to collect tolls from toll payment, will come Wednesday. The two torn relations committee will vote on the bill, and if the Senate's President Taft's recent reports to Congress on Illinois and other measures are regarded in some quarters as an attempt to bring the Senate to a standstill with less than all three bills to be passed by the end of the session, is felt that the passage of a trade commission bill as a senatorial bill will be the last to be taken.

Senate to Present TECH BOYS TO PRESENT BY BERNARD SHAW

CHURCH IS IN NEED
OF A "REFORMATION,"
SAYS DR. HOLDERBY

At meeting of several church leaders yesterday Dr. Holderby spoke on the "Uncertain Attitude of the Church Towards the Great Moral Reforms of the present."

The sermon is in part, as follows:

"The charge given by the Apostle Paul to the church of Corinth, he wrote, 'Stand fast in the faith, quite you like men' is a charge which applies to the church of the present day. To stand fast in the faith means to stand for the truth, and to stand for the gospel. It is the command of a general to his soldiers—stand firm in the ranks."

"But the church is not obeying this command of her captain today. She is not even able to stand to the command. The church today is doubting some of the cardinal doctrines of the gospel. The doctrine of the atonement—the Daily of Jesus Christ—of eternal punishment—the virgin birth of Jesus are all being doubted by people in the church, as never before."

There is also a lack of aggressiveness in the church, which is a quality which is truly admirable. The mild-mannered church is but little fighting going on. There is no enemy to come along to fight.

"The church is in much need of a leader. We need a Luther and Calvin to stand up and teach the church, Atlanta and Georgia, the way of the cross."

The Methodist church today is in three or four times greater in numbers and wealth than it was in 1880, but it could not now control three or four thousand members.

Dr. Jones, using calm language throughout his address, and not once raising his voice, said: "No other player club in Atlanta has ever staged a play from a book of Bernard Shaw's, but it is one of the best, I think, of his more recent plays."
