GERMAN CRUISER GELER INTERNS AT HONOLULU

The ship was given 24 hours longer to decide whether or not to leave.

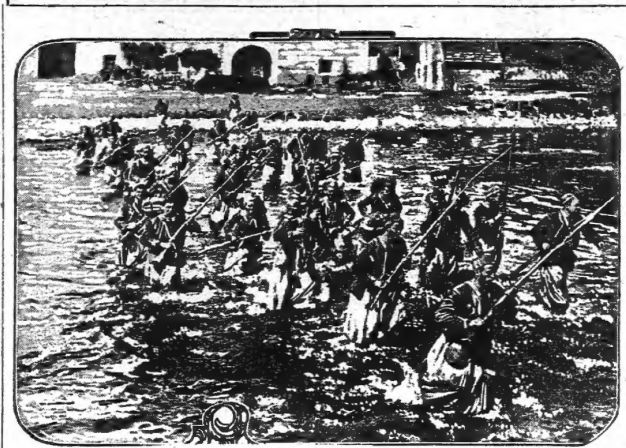

NEW PRESIDENT ELECTED BY VILLA

Alleged Gen. Gutierrez Has
Been Imprisoned by Car-
ranza's Foes for Refusing
to Yield to Their Demands.

New York, November 18.—General Guadalupe Gutierrez, elected president of Mexico at the Aguascalientes convention, has been imprisoned by General Villa, according to a telegram said to come from General Carranza and made public here tonight by the Mexican bureau of information. The same agency last week had reported that Gutierrez had repudiated the acts of the convention.

The telegram accredited to Carranza did not say where the new president had been captured or where he was incarcerated. The reason for his arrest and confinement, the message said, was that he had refused to be dominated by Villa's demands.

The telegram follows: "I wish to inform you that General Gutierrez, who repudiated the Aguascalientes convention, has been captured by General Villa and imprisoned. The reason for his arrest is that he refused to be dominated by Villa's demands."

"I wish further to inform you that I consider the action of the convention as a farce and for that reason alone I am forced to repudiate it."

The convention, which was dominated by Villistas and reactionaries, failed to accomplish its purpose, it is said, out of a desire to work out a set of regulations and rules by which Mexico might attain its normal conditions of peace and prosperity. They went and appointed another provisional president, hoping to be able to dominate the country, they realized that Gutierrez would not follow the dictation of Villa, they said.

**NOTHING TO ALARM
AT VERA CRUZ.**

Washington, November 18.—There is "nothing alarming" about the report that General Gutierrez has been captured by General Carranza, according to a dispatch from Vera Cruz, Brigadier Fustano reported today to Secretary Garrison. Reports of possible attacks on the American embassy had prompted Mr. Garrison to ask for information. General Fustano's dispatch follows:

"There is nothing to be alarmed in local conditions. Many unusual rumors have prevailed for some time. I think it better to disregard them. The friends here of General Gutierrez, who was one of the leaders of the revolution, are reported to have been captured by Carranza's forces. The city is preparing to lay the matter to rest."

U.S. TROOPS GUARDED ARKANSAS MINERS

So Far No Clash Has Occurred Between Miners and Troops—A Sketch of the Trouble in Arkansas.

Prairie Creek, Ark., November 3.—Camp Lindsey M. Garrison, one of the quartermasters here have been designated, was the scene for the inhabitants of Hartford Valley today. Hundreds poured into Prairie Creek from the surrounding settlements in the valley and fraternized with the troops and inspected the quarters.

So far there has been no clash between the miners and the soldiers. A number of men congregated at Hartford last night, and it was feared some trouble might develop, but the night passed peacefully.

The troops are here to put an end to disorders which have attended attempts of the Roche-Denham Coal company to operate its mines on the valley on the "open shop" plan.

History of the Trouble.
Hartford Valley's trouble date back to March 3 last, when the company posted notice that its mine No. 2, the only one then being operated, ordering the miners to clean up and remove their tools. The mine remained closed until April 3, when the miners were notified they could return to work on the "open shop" plan. At the same time the Southern Coal Operators' association, of which the Roche-Denham company was a member, was in agreement with the miners which did not expire until July 3.

Shortly after this outbreak a temporary injunction restraining the miners from interfering with the operation of the mine was issued. Later, United States Judge Tripper at Little Rock in the absence of Judge Frank Youmans, at Fort Smith, this action was taken in the federal court because of the fact that the mine was controlled by the Mammoth vein. Coal mines in the state are controlled by the Mammoth vein. Judge Tripper, at Fort Smith, May 15, granted an injunction against the miners, and the miners were stationed at the mine. The miners were ordered to clean up and remove their tools on or before November 5.

It was at this stage that the Roche-Denham company was placed under the protection of the government through receivership proceedings. Franklin D. Roosevelt, president, was named as the biggest outbreak developed on July 17, when a strike was staged at mine No. 2, between a mob of several hundred men and the guards and non-commissioned employees of the company. Thousands of shots were exchanged, John J. Baker, a non-commissioned employee, was killed and three bodies buried in a cash near the mine. At the same time mine No. 2 was closed and the strike was ended.

These acts of violence in the face of federal court orders and the inability of the United States marshal to enforce the law resulted in the government sending federal troops to the valley. After looking over the situation, Roger W. Felt, United States marshal, recommended the sending of federal troops to the valley as the only way to compose the situation.

After a conference, November 2, between Attorney General Gregory and Secretary of War Wood, the president issued a proclamation sending United States military forces into the valley. GERMANS FOILED BY THREE BUNKS

Kaiser's Artillery Wasted Many Shells at Pont-a-Mousson—French Cans and Slaughtered Germans.

Pont-a-Mousson, November 1.—(Correspondence of the Associated Press.)
Aside the last 1-inch gun of a column of the French, the Germans, aided by a Bavarian soldier with a bayonet, Monsieur Bertrand, a round shouldered, white-haired veteran of the war of 1870, and deputy mayor of Pont-a-Mousson, was carried from the city as chief hostages of the German in the procession which marked the end of the occupation by three Bavarian regiments.

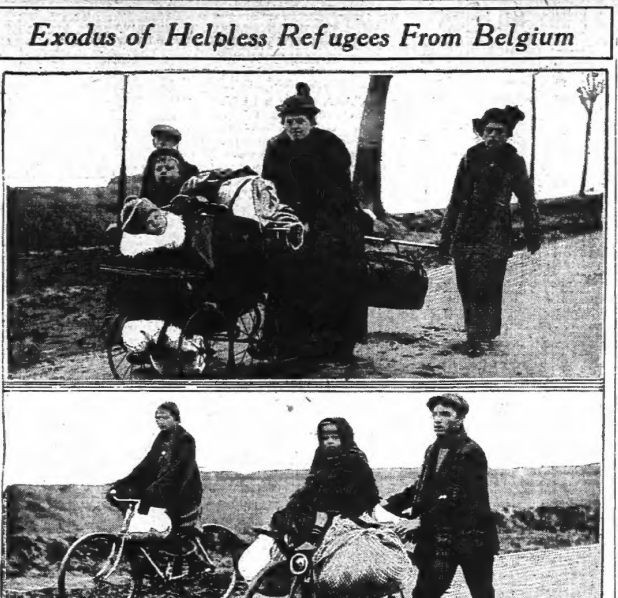
