# Georgia's Transportation Facilities

Georgia has the largest railroad mileage of any Southern State east of the Mississippi, and, with Southern State east of the Mississippi, ann, with the exception of Texas and Missouri, the largest of any of the sixteen States in the entire Southern group. Texas has 16,460 miles of railroad, Missouri group. Texas has 16,400 miles of railroad, assessor. \$\frac{2}{2}\$, and Georgia 7,536. The railroad milesge of the remainder of the South is set forth as follows in the Manufacturers Record: Alabama, 5,524; Arkansas, 5,439; Florida, 5,184; Kentucky, 4,043; Lounansas, 5,433; piorica, 5,434; keintays, 7,404). Isiana, 5,473; Maryland, including the District of Columbia, 1,624; Mississippi, 4,384; North Carolina, 5,709; Oklahoma, 6,497; South Carolina, 3,715; Tennessee, 4.192; Virginia, 4.686; and West Virginia

Georgia's progress in the field of transportation facilities is strikingly witnessed by the fact that in 1871 it had only 1.875 miles of railway. In 1880 this had increased to 2,432 miles; in 1890 to 4,557; in 1910 to 7,442 miles and 1913 to 7,536 miles. It is noteworthy, too, that there are forty-eight distinct lines of railroad in active operation in Georgia, a greater number of individual lines than are to be found in any other State of the Union.

The growth of electric railways has been

pronounced in Georgia than in any other part of the Southeast, and recent years have witnessed a notable increase in interurban lines. These develop-ments have lately been accompanied by an even more remarkable advance in the improvement of public highways. The State is credited with some 84,000 miles of highway, of which 22,000 are classed as "im-proved." This last estimate may appear somewhat too liberal in its employment of the term "im proved," but Georgia's progress in good roads is un great, and as soon as a system of State on is adopted, its good roads work will be given fresh impetus.

A State's development depends very largely or A States development depends very largely on facilities for transportation, whether they be in the form of steam and electric railroads, navigable rivers, or public highways.
